



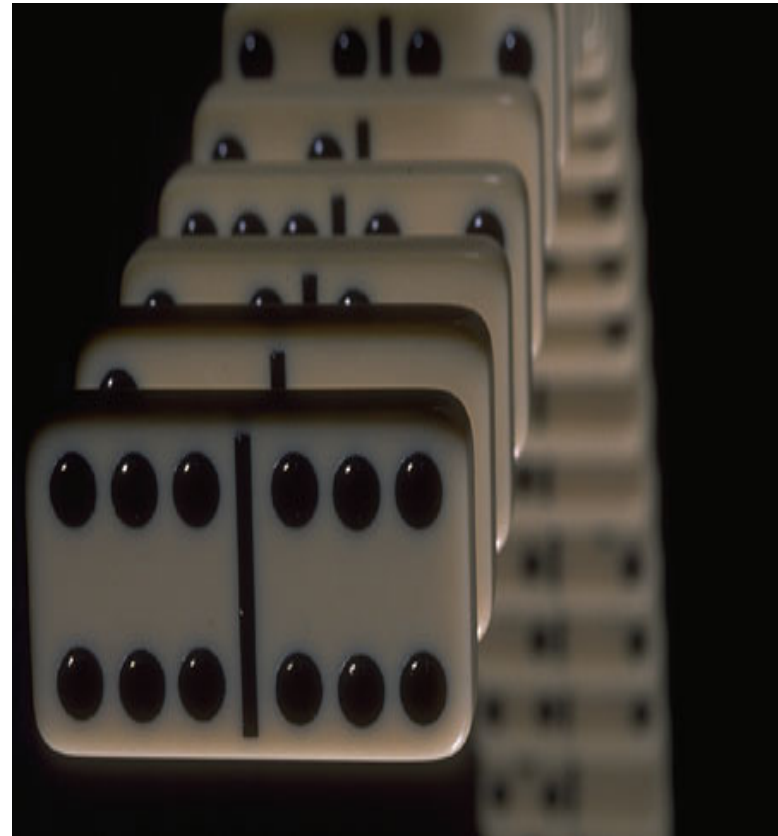

Interoperability Standards

- Government organisations can share and integrate information and business processes by using common standards in a consistent way.





Who uses the e-GIF?

- Public Service departments are required to adopt the e-GIF. The wider State sector are encouraged to adopt the e-GIF, and local government are invited to use it
- If local government use e-GIF standards, the growth of online services across government will be accelerated
- Local government representatives are involved in developing the standards

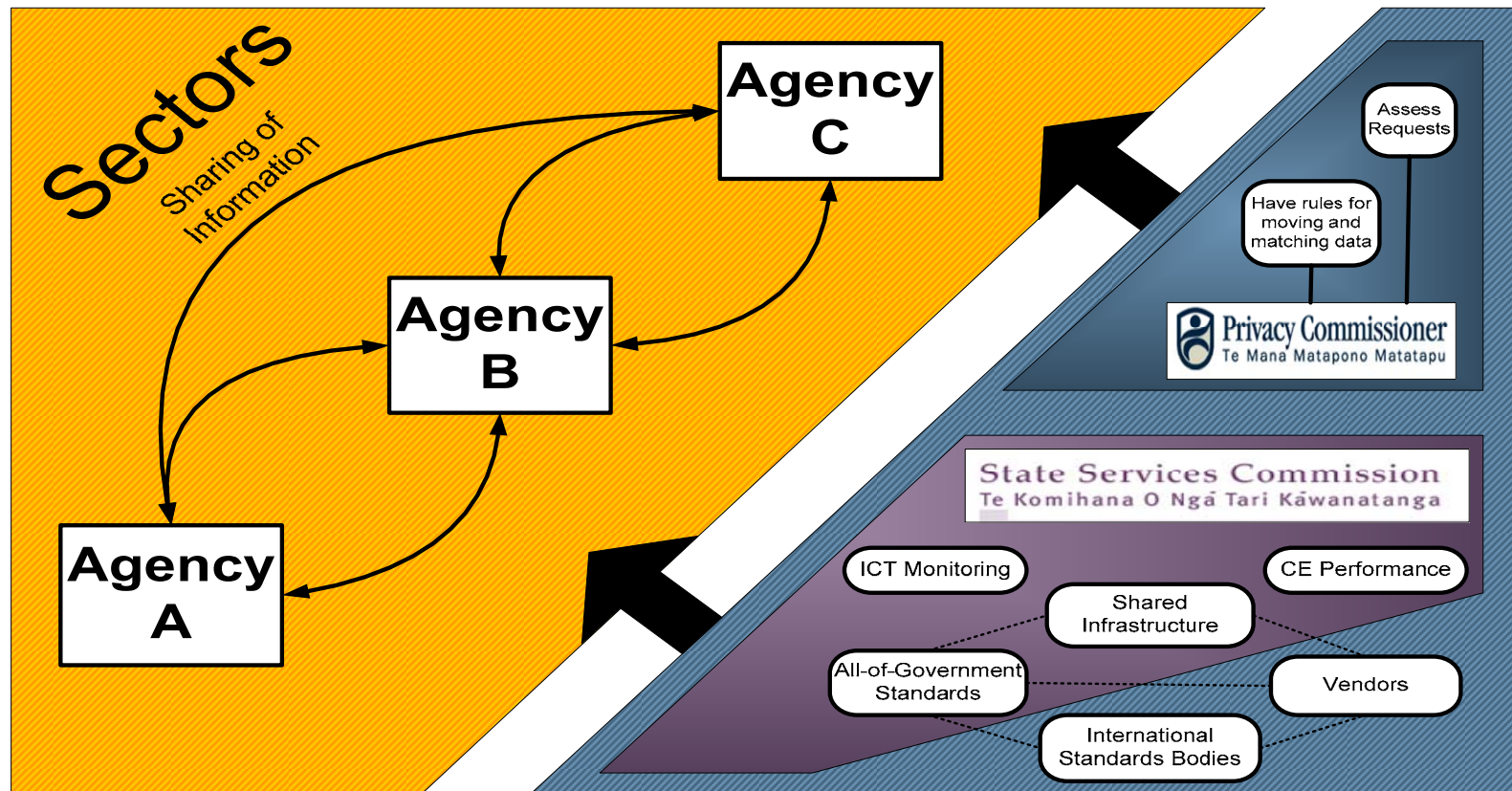

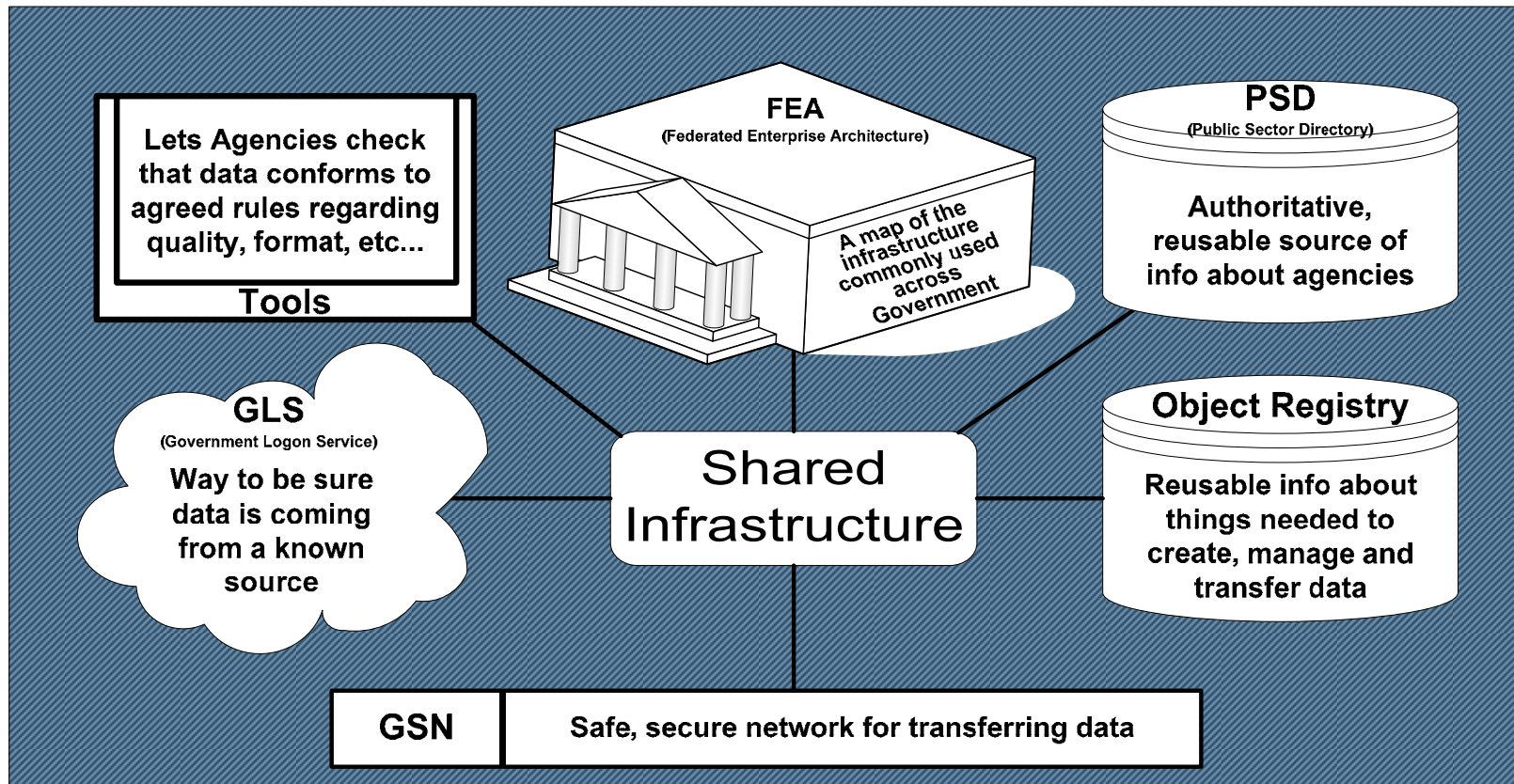


Sharing of Data Between Agencies



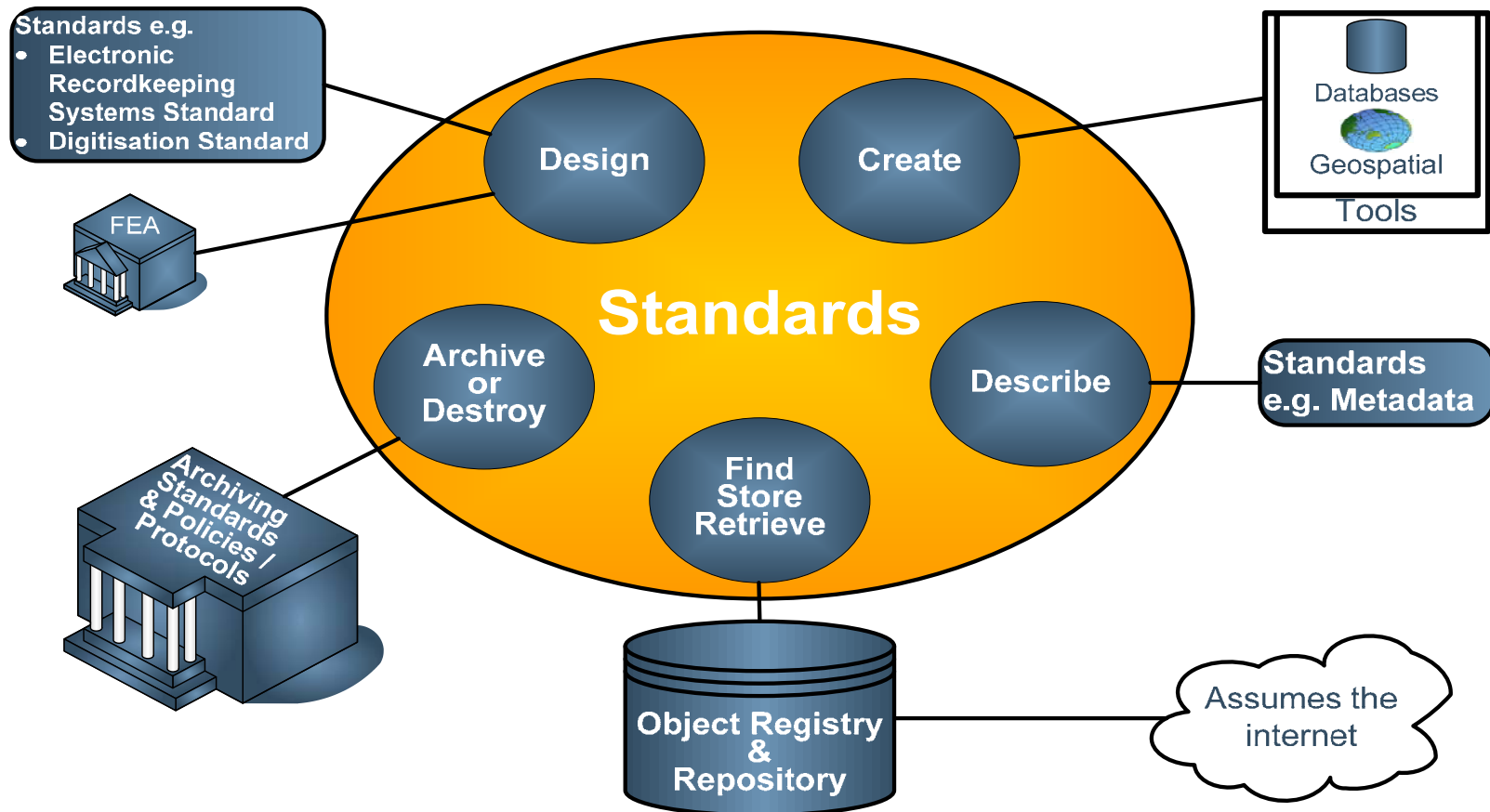


Sharing of Data Between Agencies



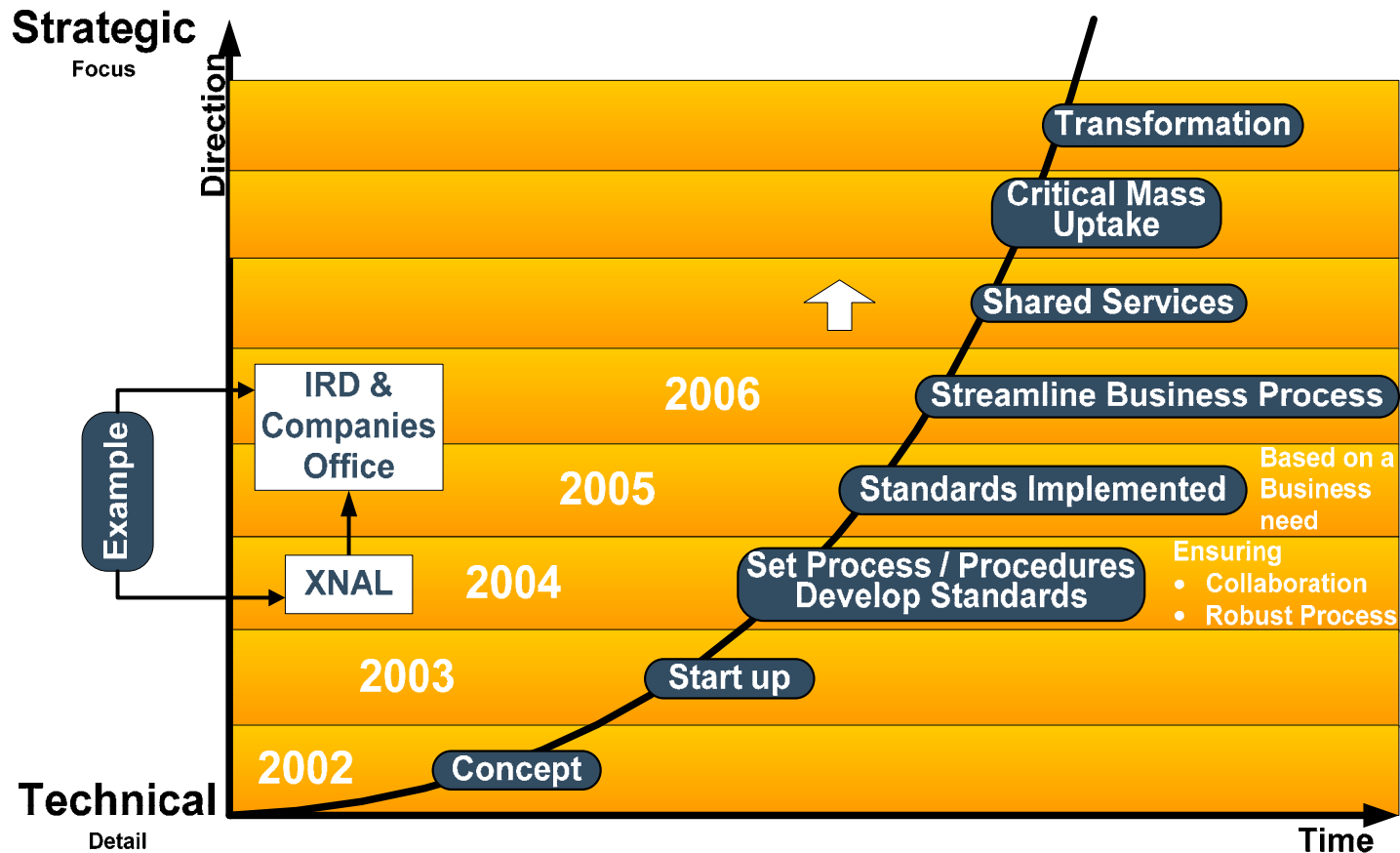


Create, Find, Maintain & Store Information Assets
